




# BMPPD-Stamm Wiesbaden

### Description of the local group:

The Confederation of Muslim Scouts in Germany is a non-profit organisation. It was founded in 2010.

There are currently twelve scout groups in Hessen, Rhineland-Palatinate, Northrhine-Westphalia, Hamburg and Berlin.

The basis of our work is the teachings of Robert Baden-Powell. He was the founder of the scouting movement.

We also follow the Koran, the holy scripture of the Muslims. The BMPPD is committed to the free democratic basic order of the Federal Republic of Germany and to the notions of order as they are written down in the states constitutions.

The BMPPD is not ideologically or politically bound to any other group. We promote the development of young people and want them to take on social responsibility. Another focus of our work is the congress of different religions and cultures.

### Who we are:

A group of the BMPPD currently exists in Wiesbaden. The members are between 7 and 21 years old.

### What we do:

We meet at regular group activities. Our leaders prepare age-based offers for these meetings.

We have activities for every age bracket that help young people to develop themselves. From painting, handicrafts and games, to working out a project independently. Of course, we also learn many scouting techniques.

This includes, for example, knotting, botany/plant science or handling/how to use tools. Another important part of being a scout involves camping and touring. We also meet with other scouting associations. The program of camping and touring is also varied. There are fun and challenges for all ages, such as off-road games, Olympics, hikes and campfires.
