Description of the local group:

The Student Council Wiesbaden represents the interests of all students who attend a secondary school. We represent the students in relation to local politics and stand up for their rights. We also organise events, demonstrations and many other things.

Who we are:

Every year, the Student Council Wiesbaden elects a board of management that represents the students. In addition to one school council representative and two deputy municipal school representatives, up to five assessors are elected. Two delegates are also elected annually for the Student Council of the state Hessen.

What we do:

The Student Council works in committees and organises diverse projects for pupils. Together with the Youth Parliament in Wiesbaden, we formed the first student movement of Fridays-For-Future to give impulses for environmental protection in Wiesbaden. In addition, our self-formed working groups deal with topics such as digitisation at Wiesbaden's schools, upcoming school renovations and new buildings, transportation by bus and bicycle, and health promotion for students. We are in close contact with the municipal and state education authorities.

How can I participate?

Every seven to twelve weeks there is a plenum/general meeting in the city hall, to which all members of the Student Council as well as interested students and teachers are gladly invited. There, school representatives report on their current concerns of their school, the board of management presents its work, applications are discussed and the pupils' problems are addressed.
